

## 2020 COVID-19 Guidelines for First Tee NWA Camps/LSE Classes

- 1) Daily temperature checks for all coaches; temperatures will be logged for our records
- 2) Participants and coaches will be physically/socially distanced throughout their stations and during breaks.
- 3) Participants and coaches will be required to wash hands each time they come in for breaks and hand sanitizer will be available for use at all times.
- 4) Coaches will be checking participants in and out using staggered release times to avoid everyone leaving at once.
- 5) Any child that complains of not feeling well will be moved to an isolated area and have their temperature checked. Their parents will be contacted immediately to pick them up.
- 6) Participants will be able to borrow clubs during camps. Whatever clubs the participant is given on the first day will be tagged with their name, and that participant will be the only one to use those clubs throughout the week. Clubs will be sanitized after use each day.
- 7) Participants will be encouraged to use the restroom prior to all activities, however if they have to use the restroom during activity, only one child will be allowed in the restroom at a time.
- 8) Coaches and participants will not be required to wear masks but can do so if they are more comfortable.
- 9) Coaches will remain with the same group throughout each day.
- 10) Participants will be encouraged to bring their own water bottle each day. If they do not have a water bottle, The First Tee will provide them with a bottle of water they can refill throughout the day.
- 11) All participants will be outside during camps and LSE classes unless participants need to use the restroom. On Thursday's of Camp weeks, when serving lunch, we will allow one child at a time to come in get food and then they will have to go back outside to eat it.
